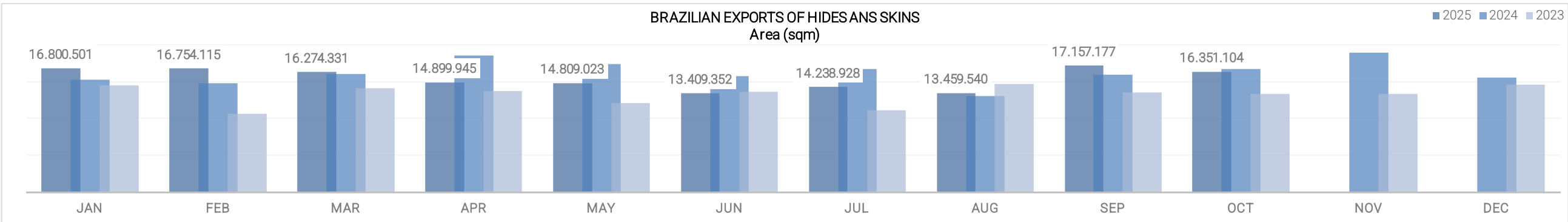
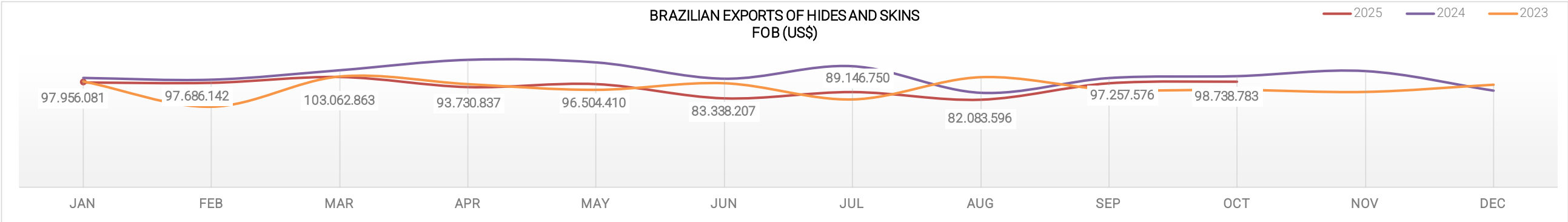
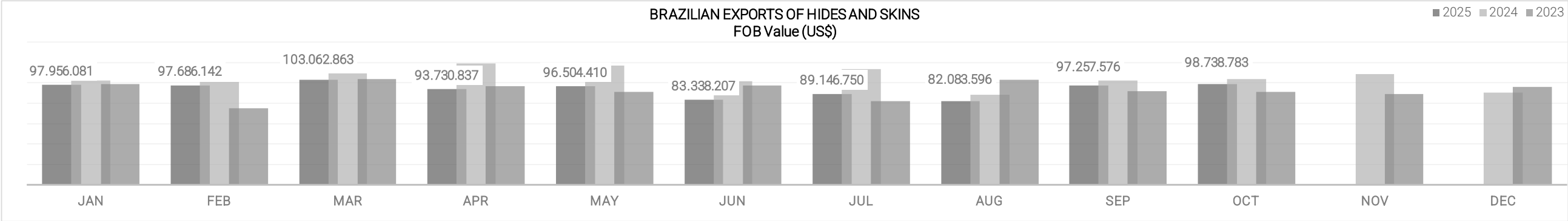

■ ANALYSIS OF TOTAL EXPORTS

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Exports of hides and skins in October 2025, according to data from SECEX (Secretariat of Foreign Trade) of the Ministry of Development, Industry, Commerce and Services and analyzed by the CICB, reached US\$ 98.7 million.

This value represents an increase of 1.5% compared to the previous month, but a decrease of 5.0% compared to the same month last year, when exports totaled US\$ 103.9 million.

In volume, 16.4 million square meters and 57.8 thousand tons were exported, which represent a decrease of 1.9% and an increase of 10.3%, respectively, compared to October 2024. Compared to September of this year, there were reductions of 4.7% in the area and 4.2% in weight.

The period from January to October this year totaled US\$ 939.5 million, 11.1% below the same interval in 2024, also with a decrease of 3.7% in area, but an increase of 5.5% in weight.

■ ANALYSIS OF DESTINATIONS

The three main destinations for Brazilian leather presented the following data in the year:

China (excluding Hong Kong) maintained its share of 29.9% (previously 29.9%) in value and 43.6% (43.8%) in area, with a decrease of 15.2% (-14.4%) in value, and now a decrease of 0.1% (+2.8%) in area.

The United States in second place in the ranking, with 13.4% (13.9%) of share in value, and 6.9% (7.1%) in area, has decreases of 12.5% (-12.2%) in value and 2.6% (-3.5%) in area.

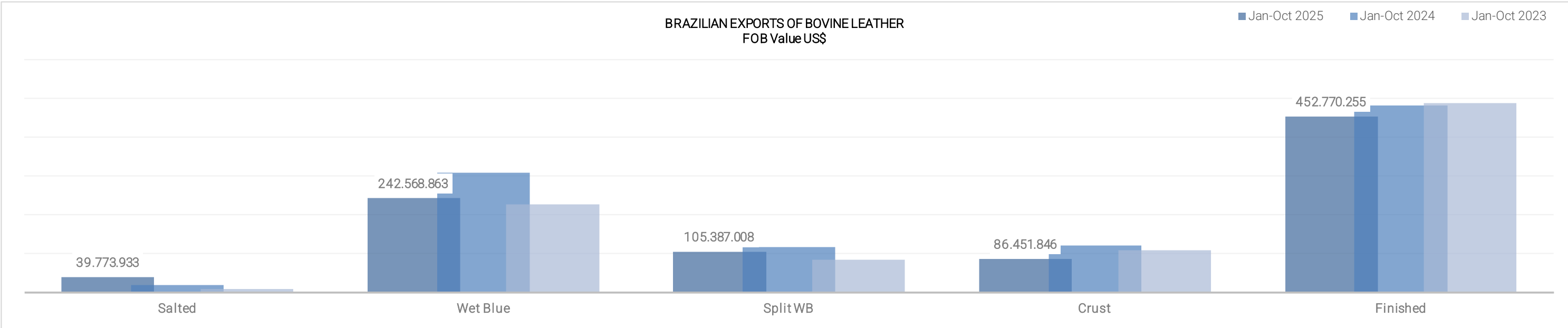
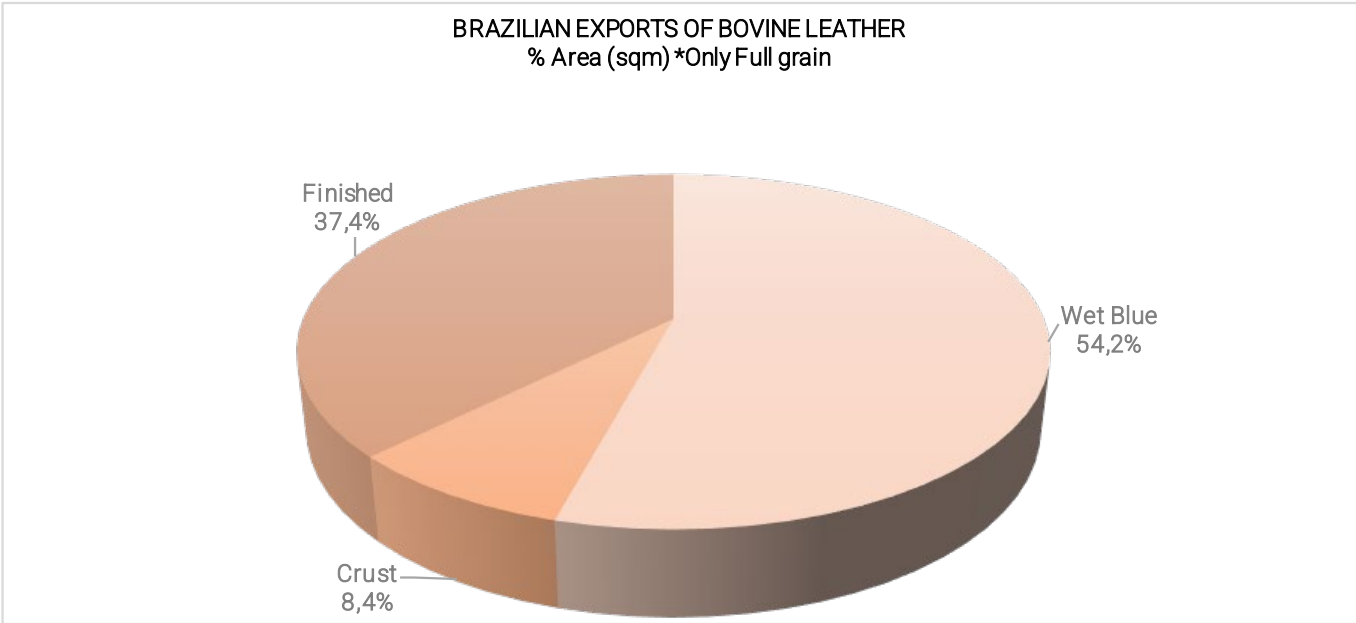
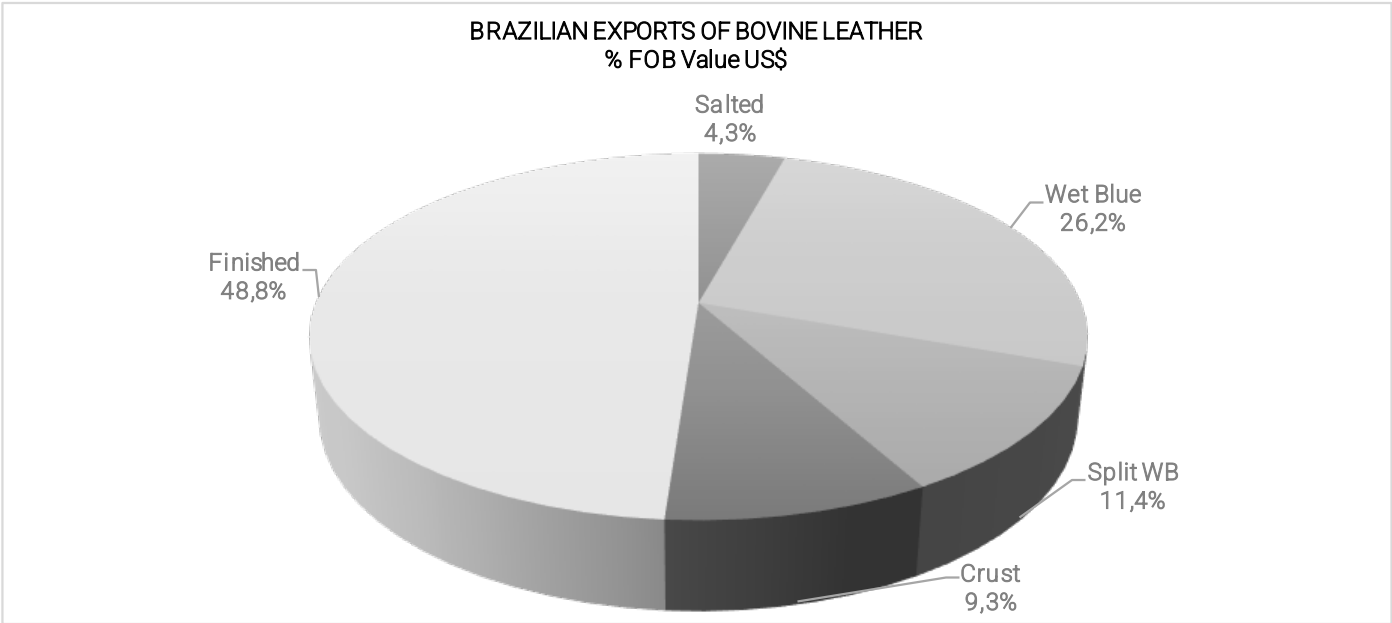
Italy in third, maintaining its shares of 11.1% (11.1%) in value and 12.9% (12.9%) in area, has decreases of 15.0% (-17.4%) in value and 5.8% (-8.6%) in area.

Brazilian leather shipments in October resulted in worsening in the accumulated value indicators for China and the United States, compared to the accumulated until the previous month. On the other hand, for Italy, which still registers drops in purchases of Brazilian leather over the same period last year, there are improvements.

Among the other TOP10 countries, there are increases in shipments to South Korea (+64.1% in value and +71.6% in area) and to Spain (+56.1% and +60.7%).

■ ANALYSIS OF TYPES OF LEATHER

Brazilian exports of bovine leather by type showed the following changes in the period, compared to the same interval of the previous year:

Wet blue, with a share of 26.2% (26.3%) in value and 54.2% (54.6%) in area, with decreases of 21.1% (-21.4%) in value and -1.6% (-0.2%) in area.

Split WB maintains 11.4% (11.4%) of share in value, with decreases of 9.4% (-9.4%) in value and 7.7% (-8.6%) in area.

Crust, with a share of 9.3% (9.2%) in value and 8.4% (8.2%) in area, shows reductions of 28.5% (-30.1%) in value and 22.0% (-23.8%) in area.

Finished leather registered a share of 48.8% (49.0%) in value and 37.4% (37.2%) in area, with a decrease of 5.8% (-6.4%) in value, but an increase of 1.5% (+0.5%) in area.

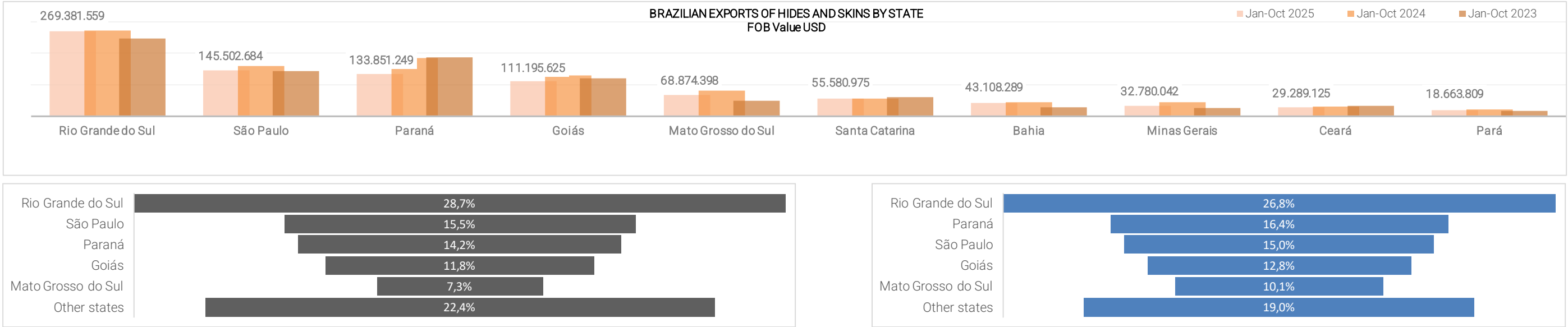
There was a general improvement, even if slight, in the indicators of all types of leather, with shipments in October. The exception was the volume of wet blue leather, as it showed stability in exports and now shows a drop of 1.6%.

Among skins, sheep and goats continue to perform well in the year, with growth of 50.7% and 90.0%, respectively. Hair on hides now shows stability in the annual comparison.

Salted hides have historically recorded shipments with the highest monthly value and volume.

■ ANALYSIS OF STATES

In the period up to October, exports from Brazilian states presented the following highlights:

Among the TOP10, some states are close to stability in value in exports, such as Rio Grande do Sul, Bahia and Santa Catarina, with -0.8%, -2.3% and -2.6%, respectively.

The states with the worst performance in value in the year are Paraná (-27.9%) and Minas Gerais (-26.3%).

Considering the area shipped, the biggest increases are in Pará (+9.9%) and Rio Grande do Sul (+9.1%).

There is no change in the ranking, with Rio Grande do Sul in first place in the three indicators (28.7% share in value, 26.8% in area and 17.7% in weight), with São Paulo in second in value (15.5%) and Paraná in second in volume, both in area (16.4%) and weight (16.6%).

■ CLOSING REMARKS

In October, Brazilian leather exports totaled US\$ 98.7 million, the second highest value of the year. The volume shipped also remained above 16 million square meters, signaling an improvement in the scenario after three months (from June to August) of weak and worrying performance.

Compared to September, there was an increase in the exported value and a reduction in volume, both in area and weight. This behavior points to a better average price, with a greater share of value-added leathers.

Among the main destinations, the increases in shipments to Italy and Vietnam stood out, while the two largest markets — China and the United States — showed a decrease. Mexico also recorded a recovery in exports, starting to show a positive balance in the year.

Despite the meeting held in Malaysia between the presidents of Brazil and the United States, there has not yet been any favorable decision regarding the reduction or suspension of tariffs, which continues to harm the performance of Brazilian exports. The leather sector feels the impact directly, also indirectly affected through the national production of leather footwear, since the United States represents the main destination for these products.

On the other hand, the U.S. government ratified, for a period of one year, the suspension of the increase in tariffs on imports from China, through the signing of an executive order. The economic agreement was established after the meeting between the leaders of the world's two largest economies. -
